Applying for the Corporate Scholarship Program

What the Corporate Scholarship Program Offers

As part of the Corporate Scholarship Program, Credit Suisse offers a maximum scholarship of CHF 32,000 per cycle to a selected participant who is paying the cost of the course from his or her own pocket. Where possible, Credit Suisse will also offer the scholarship holder the opportunity to write course assignments or the final thesis of the Executive MBA on bank-related topics.

Prerequisites for Suitability

The basic prerequisites for applying for a Credit Suisse scholarship are as follows. Candidates must be admitted by the University of St. Gallen to study for an Executive MBA or Omnium Global Executive MBA. They must also be paying the full cost of the course themselves. However, applicants do not need to be working in the financial services sector or have a background in banking.

Selection Criteria

Two main criteria are used. On the one hand, the process considers the personality of the applicants, their personal goals and the associated reasons for continuing their education, plus the relevance of the Corporate Scholarship. On the other hand, the process also examines potential opportunities for the scholarship holder to work with Credit Suisse within the context of semester assignments or the final thesis.

How to Apply

Applications do not have to be in a specific format. As well as your CV with a photo, an outline of your career to date and a description of any features that make you special, we would like to know why you think that Credit Suisse should choose you in particular to receive the Corporate Scholarship.
